Chris Swinford, the International Director for SIBI overseas Schools, spent time in the Philippines teaching Evangelism Seminars in our 4 PIBI Schools. The Administrators, Faculties, Fieldworkers, and Students said they had gained so much from Chris’ lessons, especially since the 4 schools will be spending April and May out in 12 Provinces preaching, baptizing, and planting Churches. Everyone is excited about the semester ending March 28th. So they can go out and work with the local churches in Evangelism.

Since April and May are “summer” months, and most Philippine schools are out for those months, the PIBI will team-up with Christian women and the teenagers in the churches, and teach “VBS,” in order to set up Bible studies with the families of the Children. Gospel Meetings, and Campaigns are Conducted by the PIBI Faculty, Fieldworkers, and Students.
